CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4881

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing submittal of a proposal to and acceptance of a grant award contract with the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation ("IAC"); creating a new project within the Grant Control Fund; amending the budget for the Grant Control Fund by appropriating previously unanticipated revenues to that fund.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Bellevue has approved a Parks and Open Space System Plan for additional acquisition of property for future development of a community/city-wide park south of I-90; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue considers it in the best interest of the public to expand opportunities for community/city-wide recreation through acquisition of open space for construction of recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of this parcel of 14 acres located south of I-90, and adjoining the Beebe and Robertson parcels which were previously purchased for development of recreational facilities will provide 49 acres of contiguous open space for future park development.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of state and federal laws, funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and habitat conservation areas and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, any fund assistance so received will be used for acquisition of this parcel; and

WHEREAS, the City's share of the project will be derived from CIP Project No. P-AD-15; and

WHEREAS, the City does hereby certify that the City is responsible to support all non-cash commitments to the local share should they not materialize; and

WHEREAS, any facility developed with financial aid through the IAC will be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility or habitat conservation area and retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, IAC, and any affected federal agency; and

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WHEREAS, adequate notification has been given and the opportunity provided for public input and published notices have identified affected flood plains and or wetlands, if applicable; and

WHEREAS, the site plan has been adopted by the Bellevue City Council; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application to and to execute a grant award contract with the IAC for the acquisition of this 14 acre parcel (Peltola) located south of I-90 (CIP Project No. P-AD-15), a copy of which has been Clerk's Receiving No. 21951.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project within the Grant Control Fund, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the Grant proposal and acceptance are:

Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation	\$500,000.00
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Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, the budget for the Grant Control Fund is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized to the Grant Control Fund, currently anticipated in the following amount:

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
Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant award should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


