CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4886

AN ORDINANCE relating to 150th Avenue SE roadway improvements between SE 36th Street and SE Newport Way, CIP Project No. PW-R-105: authorizing execution of an interlocal agreement with King County to accept contributions; authorizing execution of an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation to accept grant funds; increasing the Transportation Grant fund appropriation to reflect acceptance of grant funds; increasing the General CIP Fund appropriation to reflect acceptance of the King County and grant funds; increasing the local share of the project; and authorizing execution of an agreement with H.S. Lochner, Inc. to provide engineering services for the preliminary design of these improvements.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute that certain interlocal Agreement with King County to accept approximately \$2,344,000 in King County contributions towards improvements to 150th Avenue SE, between SE 36th Street and SE Newport Way, CIP Project No. PW-R-105, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23233.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute that certain Agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for the acceptance of \$500,000 in federal ISTE A grant funds, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23234.

Section 3. At the time of execution of the Agreement specified in Section 2 and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Transportation Grant Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

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Section 5. Upon execution of the Agreement specified in Section 2 the budget for the Transportation Grant Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grants and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 6. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Transportation Grant Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Transportation Grant Fund that may be created by these grants or by making necessary program expenditures associated with these grants.

Section 7. The General CIP Fund appropriation shall hereby be increased by \$2,844,000 to reflect the acceptance of the King County contribution and federal ISTE A grant funds.

Section 8. The local share of the 150th Avenue SE road improvement project is hereby increased from \$1,200,000 to \$1,556,000 by committing \$356,000 of future transportation CIP revenues to the project.

Section 9. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with H. S. Lochner, Inc. for engineering services for 150th Avenue SE, between SE 36th Street and SE Newport Way, CIP Project No. PW-R-105, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23235.

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Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


