

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5444

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager to execute the 2003-2007 Emergency Medical Services Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life Support (ALS) Agreements with King County, amending the 2003-2004 General Fund Budget and Ordinance No. 5426 and providing for 4.32 additional Fire Department personnel.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the 2003-2007 Emergency Medical Services Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life support (ALS) Agreements with King County, copies of which Agreements have been given Clerk's Receiving Nos. 34063 and 34064, respectively.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to spend the same as authorized in said Agreements.

Section 3. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the additional budget revenues is:

Section 4. Upon execution of said Amendments, Ordinance No. 5426 and the 2003-2004 General Fund budget are hereby amended by appropriating additional revenue to be received during the 2003 and 2004 fiscal years to the General Fund in the amounts specified in Section 4 of this ordinance. The source of said funds, which were not anticipated in the 2003-2004 General Fund Budget, along with the purposes for which they are being appropriated, including 4.32 additional Fire Department personnel are specified in the agreement referenced in Section 1. of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
