ORDINANCE NO. 5553

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation, Office of Local Programs, for the acceptance of federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds awarded through the PSRC Countywide competition to support the City's 2005 Urban Overlay Project, part of the Street Overlays Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1); and amending the appropriation for the 2003-2009 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan budget by increasing the budget for the Street Overlays program (PW-M-1) by \$1,397,095 for implementation of the Urban Overlay Project.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation, Office of Local Programs, for the acceptance of federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds awarded through the PSRC Countywide competition to support the City's 2005 Urban Overlay Project, part of the Street Overlays Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1), a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 37085.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. The 2003-2009 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan budget adopted by Ordinance No. 5426 on December 2, 2002, as previously amended is hereby further amended by increasing the budget for the Street Overlays program (PW-M-1) by \$1,397,095 for implementation of the Urban Overlay Project, provided however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

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Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
