

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5658

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an amendment to the State Homeland Security Program Homeland Security Subgrant Agreement (and necessary supplements) with King County to accept an additional \$157,901.44 for upgrading firefighting equipment; establishing a project within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; appropriating additional revenues to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; authorizing expenditures of said grant funds; and authorizing interfund loans.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) Homeland Security Subgrant Agreement (and necessary supplements) with King County to accept \$157,901.44 in grant funds for upgrading firefighting equipment. The original SHSP Agreement was given Clerk's Receiving No. 36412. A copy of the Amendment has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 39196.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Amendment.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Amendment and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Upon acceptance of said grant funds, the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or her designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Operating Grants and Donations Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


