

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5676

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$132,000 in Federal Safe Routes to School funding; amending the 2005-2011 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan by increasing the project budget for the Major Safety Improvements Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-46) by \$132,000 for pedestrian safety awareness efforts at Stevenson Elementary School; and increasing the 2005-2006 General CIP fund appropriation by \$132,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$132,000 in Federal Safe Routes to School funding, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 39828.

Section 2. The City's 2005–2011 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended by increasing the project budget for the Major Safety Improvements Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-46) by \$132,000 reflecting the Federal Safe Routes to School funding.

Section 3. The City's 2005-2006 General CIP Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$132,000.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:


WSDOT                      \$132,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


