

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5771

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of:
1) An agreement with King County METRO (KCM) for \$174,980 in federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funding and \$159,000 in state I-405 Construction Mitigation funding for a Downtown Bellevue Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Market Enhancement Project; 2) An agreement with the Bellevue Downtown Association (BDA) for implementation services as part of the Downtown Bellevue TDM Market Enhancement Project in an amount not to exceed \$265,460 and an additional \$150,000 in services conditioned upon receiving \$150,000 in state Growth and Transportation Efficiency Center grant funds; 3) Amendment of the 2007-2008 General CIP fund to increase the appropriation by \$239,970; and, 4) Amendment of the 2007-2013 Bellevue CIP to increase the project budget for Transportation Demand Management (CIP Plan No. PW-R-87) by \$239,970 in contributions from KCM.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement (and any necessary supplements) with KCM for \$174,980 in federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funding and \$159,000 in state I-405 Construction Mitigation funding for a Downtown Bellevue Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Market Enhancement Project a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 41847.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the Bellevue Downtown Association (BDA) for implementation services as part of the Downtown Bellevue TDM Market Enhancement Project in an amount not to exceed \$265,460 and an additional \$150,000 in services conditioned upon receiving \$150,000 in state Growth and Transportation Efficiency Center grant funds, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 41736.

Section 3. The City's 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$239,970 to recognize funding from the following:

State I-405 Construction Mitigation Funds (through KCM)	<u>159,000</u>
Total From Anticipated Sources:	<u>\$239,970</u>

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified herein shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 4. The City's 2007-2013 General CIP plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for CIP PW-R-87 by \$239,970 to add these additional unanticipated funds.

Section 5. the City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




