ORDINANCE NO. 5818

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2007-2008 General Fund budget and appropriation to increase by \$58,112 representing funding from the Eastside Narcotics Task Force (ENTF) for its use of a Bellevue Police Department canine officer and authorizing an additional temporary FTE that will be paid from the ENTFF funds.

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously approved an Interlocal Agreement (CR # 39295, May 16, 2006) between certain eastside cities and King County to combine resources to fight drug related crime; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement authorizes the ENTFF to expend funds from its Special Task Force Account for special needs including "to pay the expenses to maintain an ENTFF canine drug team"; and

WHEREAS, the ENTFF has authorized reimbursement to the City of Bellevue for the services of one of its canine officers; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department desire to provide a canine officer to the ENTFF in return for reimbursement for the full costs of said position, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Upon receipt of \$58,112 from the ENTFF, the 2007-2008 General Fund budget and appropriation, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget and appropriation to said Fund by \$58,112 to reflect additional revenues received from the ENTFF.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 2. The Police Department shall have one additional FTE for the period that the officer is on loan to the ENTFF funded fully with ENTFF funds. Said FTE shall be eliminated upon the termination of the loaning of a canine officer.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




