ORDINANCE NO. 5997

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of 2010 Assistance to Firefighters Grant funds from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management (FEMA), of up to \$77,640 for the purchase of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus bottles and five-inch fire hose; establishing a project within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund; appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept the 2010 Assistance to Firefighter Grant from DHS, FEMA, of up to \$77,640 for the purchase of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus bottles and five-inch fire hose, a copy of which Grant Agreement Articles is given Clerk's Receiving No. 48767.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Grant Agreement Articles.

Section 3. At the time of acceptance of said Grant Award and funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including purchase agreements to expend funds as provided in Grant Award.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon acceptance of said Grant Award, the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.




