ORDINANCE NO. 6012

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 4312 that imposed certain water connection charges for properties that developed or redeveloped within the Central Business District.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 4312 on December 7, 1991 to reimburse the City for certain costs associated with water system improvements, which served to increase capacity to properties located within the CBD; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds have been collected by the Utility from the connection charges authorized by Ordinance No. 4312 to recover the costs of the water system improvements to the CBD; and

WHEREAS, it is now appropriate to repeal Ordinance 4312, which authorized collection of said connection charges; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 4312 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the City Council.


