ORDINANCE NO. 6021

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Bellevue School District (BSD) for the assignment of a maximum of five School Resource Officers (SRO) to be stationed at Bellevue high and middle schools during the 2011-2012 school year; amending the 2011-2012 General Fund budget and appropriation to increase by \$209,228

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Agreement with Bellevue School District for the assignment of a maximum of five School Resource Officers (SRO) and receipt of \$209,228 for the 2011-2012 school year; a copy of this Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 47985.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. Upon execution of said Agreement, the 2011-2012 General Fund budget and appropriation, adopted pursuant to Ordinance 5978 on December 6, 2010 and as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget and appropriation to said Fund by \$209,228 to reflect additional revenues in the amount of the funding and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




