ORDINANCE NO. 6171

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an amendment (and supplements if necessary) to the Interlocal Agreement with King County, providing the City with \$1,650,000 in King County Conservation Futures Levy proceeds, and 2) amending the 2014 Budget by \$1,650,000 to increase the Parks and Open Space Acquisition project (CIP P-AD-82) to recognize King County Conservation Futures Levy proceeds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County, providing the City with \$1,650,000 in King County Conservation Futures Levy proceeds, a copy of which Amendment has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 53570.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said amended Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2014 Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 6089 on December 3, 2012, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for the Parks and Open Space Acquisition project (CIP P-AD- 82) by \$1,650,000.

Section 5. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said amended Interlocal Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


