RESOLUTION NO. 6859

A RESOLUTION adopting the Bellevue Transit Plan (2001-2007) and directing staff to transmit the Plan to the King County Executive and King County Council.

WHEREAS, the Bellevue City Council has identified transportation as a high priority and transit solutions as an increasingly important part of a local and regional transportation system that support land use goals and level-of-service standards as set forth in the Bellevue Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in December of 2000 the City Council determined to update the City's 1995 Transit Plan and directed staff to proceed with preparation of a Plan; and

WHEREAS, in April, 2001, the City Council adopted the Service Element of the Plan and directed staff to proceed with Capital and Policy Elements; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2003, the Transportation Commission conducted a public hearing on the proposed Plan and recommended to the Council that the Plan be adopted; now, therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Bellevue Transit Plan (2001 - 2007), a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 34069, is hereby adopted.


Section 2. Staff is directed to transmit a copies of the Plan, as adopted, to the King County Executive and King County Council.
