RESOLUTION NO. 6953

A RESOLUTION approving amendments to the Major Public Open Space Design Plan at the intersection of 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE and NE 6<sup>th</sup> St (Pedestrian Corridor), and the Pedestrian Corridor and Major Public Open Space Design Guidelines, copies of which amended Plan is given Clerk's Receiving No. 35120.

WHEREAS, Bellevue Land Use Code 20.25A.100.E.4.(d)ix requires that a Major Public Open Space Design Plan be submitted to and approved by the city Council prior to issuance of a building permit for any structure which requires construction on all or part of the major public open space; and

WHEREAS, a design plan has been submitted to the City Council in connection with the proposed construction of the Meydenbauer mixed-use project, City Center II office building, and Bellevue City Hall located at the east end of the Pedestrian Corridor at the intersection of 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE and NE 6<sup>th</sup> Street (Pedestrian Corridor); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the plan and determined that it should be approved; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Bellevue Pedestrian Corridor Guidelines and Major Public Open Space Design Plan, adopted by Resolution No. 3946, and given Clerk's Receiving No. 26377 and as amended, is hereby further amended as set forth in the attached Major Open Space Design Plan, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 35120 is approved.
