RESOLUTION NO. 7906

A RESOLUTION initiating vacation of a portion of SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street East of Bellevue Way SE and a portion of 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE South of SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street and setting a time and place for a hearing to consider such a vacation.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue petitions to initiate the vacation of a certain City right-of-way set forth in Section 1 herein and desires to set a time and place for a hearing before the City Council to consider such vacation; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby initiates the vacation, pursuant to section 14.35.030 of the Bellevue City Code, of the following City right-of-way:

A portion of SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street East of Bellevue Way SE and a portion of 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE South of SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street, more particularly described in Attachment 1 attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. A public hearing shall be held upon the proposal to vacate the City right-of-way set forth in Section 1 on May 4, 2009 at the hour of 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Bellevue City Hall, 450 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington.


Section 3. Notice of such hearing shall be provided and posted in the manner required by Sections 14.35.050 of the Bellevue City Code inviting interested persons to appear and be heard for or against the proposed vacation.

Section 4. This matter is referred to the City Manager or his designee for investigation and report, as necessary, at said public hearing.
