RESOLUTION NO. 8040

A RESOLUTION supporting Issaquah School District Propositions 1 (replacement of maintenance and operations levy), 2 (capital projects levies), and 3 (school bus levy) on the February 9, 2010 special election ballot.

WHEREAS, levy requests of the Issaquah School District for its Maintenance and Operations, Capital Projects and School Bus levies will be submitted to the voters at the February 9, 2010 election; and

WHEREAS, the Maintenance and Operations levy replaces an expiring levy and funds district education programs and school operations; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Projects levy funds education technology, school remodeling and updating of education facilities; and

WHEREAS, the School Bus levy funds new and replacement school buses; and

WHEREAS, the District has shown a strong commitment to excellence in education by establishing a state-wide reputation for quality schools; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to express support for the continuing efforts of the District to provide excellence in education and to support the District's efforts to provide the necessary funding to carry on with those efforts; now, therefore;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Bellevue hereby declares its support for and encourages approval of Issaquah School District Propositions 1 (replacement of maintenance and operations levy), 2 (capital projects levies), and 3 (school bus levy) which will be presented to the voters at the February 9, 2010 special election.


