

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 7562

A RESOLUTION authorizing the submittal of a grant application requesting a total of up to \$300,000 from the State of Washington Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC), to help offset costs associated with the renovation of the SE 40th Boat Launch.

WHEREAS, the City approved the Bellevue Parks and Open Space System Plan in 2003 that includes the acquisitions and development projects identified in these applications; and

WHEREAS, the City must aggressively seek more non-traditional funding sources to augment existing CIP dollars to achieve its goals; and

WHEREAS, for the IAC to provide funds to the City, and for the City to access these funds, the City must approve an IAC Boating Facilities Program Authorizing Resolution; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to make formal application for a grant from the IAC for a total of up to \$300,000 to help offset costs associated with the renovation of the SE 40th Boat Launch.

Section 2. If awarded a grant, any funding assistance will be used for implementation of the specific projects described above for which it was awarded.

Section 3. The City hereby certifies that, if awarded, its share of the project funding is committed and will be derived through a combination of City Capital Investment Fund dollars and State Legislative appropriation.

Section 4. The City acknowledges that any facility renovations developed with IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City and IAC.


Section 5. This resolution will become part of the formal application to IAC.


