Dr. Vandana Slatter, has a doctorate in pharmacy from the University of Washington and a bachelor's degree in pharmacy from the University of British Columbia. She also holds a Master of Public Administration degree from the Evans School of Public Affairs at UW. She was elected to the Bellevue City Council in November 2015 for a four-year term starting in January 2016.

Vandana currently serves as council liaison to the Environmental Services Commission, Special Events Committee and Youth Link Board. In addition, she represents the city on the Puget Sound Regional Council's Regional Transit Oriented Development Advisory Committee as well as the Trade Development Alliance Board.

The longtime Bellevue resident has been a trustee of the Overlake Hospital Foundation and a volunteer advisor to Bellevue College's Science Department. She helped establish an urban farm at the Lake Hills Greenbelt and is on advisory boards for two local nonprofits, Global Social Business Partners and Farmer Frog.
