



RAPID RESPONSE TIMES = POSITIVE OUTCOMES

In both Fire Suppression and Emergency Medical response, time is critical due to the rate of fire growth, tissue damage in the event of cardiac arrest, or chance of full recovery in a CVA (stroke).

Why 6 minutes or Less?



The best possible outcome for a cardiac or trauma patient occurs within the first 10 minutes of injury.



Even 1 minute can make the difference between acute deficits or full recovery.


SURVIVAL

High Rise response requires a 3 minute travel time due to the challenges of vertical response after arrival.


Goal is 10 minute response time for Ladder Companies and 8 minute response time for Battalion Commanders.

from Stations 1, 4, 5, 6, and 7




Current Battalion Chief Locations and Coverage




Battalion Commanders assume command at major incidents and provide administrative response with the following results.

Future coverage would provide for a safer scene and more effective operations.


Current Ladder Locations and Coverage
