RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

PAPER (Staples in paper OK)



Mail, Envelopes, Padded Envelopes (if padding is paper)



Brochures & Catalogs, Newspapers, Blueprints, Carbonless Forms



Phonebooks, Magazines, Paperbacks (NO hardbacks), File Folders, Ream Wrappers, Cardboard (flatten, size limit 3'X3')

PAPER & PLASTIC CUPS
(No lids, no straws)



SHREDDED PAPER



Shredded Paper
(Stuff into clear plastic bag & tie securely)

PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS
(Please rinse)



Milk & Juice Cartons, Frozen Food Boxes

GLASS
(Please rinse)



Bottles & Jars, All Colors
(Remove lids, empty & rinse. Loose lids 3" or larger ok)

METAL
(Please rinse)



Aluminum & Tin Cans
(Labels OK), Scrap metal (up to 2' X 2', 35 lbs)

LIDS



3" or larger

PLASTIC CONTAINERS



Bottles, Jars, Jugs, Tub, Take-out Containers
(Remove lids, empty & rinse, no Styrofoam)

PLASTIC BAGS



Bubble Wrap, Shrink Wrap, Grocery Bags, Newspaper Bags, Dry Cleaner Bags
(Stuff into plastic bag & tie securely)

Reuse or put in garbage:

Plastic 3-ring binders; plastic sheet protectors; plastic index tabs; plastic coated or waxed cardboard; plastic utensils & straws; ceramic dishes & glasses; Styrofoam block or peanuts; laminated paper; aerosol cans; candy & food wrappers



No Food Waste:

Food scraps; paper plates/napkins/towels; pizza boxes
