- *Foster regional water planning that provides adequate water for both people and fish.*



Cascade is a non-profit organization comprised of public water suppliers formed for the purpose of providing safe, clean drinking water for its membership. The organization serves more than 370,000 residents in King County, Washington.

Cascade is actively pursuing a variety of projects that will ensure an adequate water supply for its members for decades to come.

To manage its current water supply, Cascade is utilizing the latest technologies and programs in water efficiency.

Single Family Residences

CLOTHES WASHER REBATES: Rebates up to \$100 for the purchase of selected high efficiency machines. Customers of Puget Sound Energy may be eligible for additional rebates.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM AUDITS: Free audits of eligible properties with in-ground irrigation systems.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM UPGRADE REBATES: Rebates up to \$450 for the installation of new weather-based controllers, rain sensors, and other hardware.

Multi-Family Properties

REPLACEMENT TOILETS: Free high-efficiency toilets for properties with toilets installed before 1994 or an \$80 rebate for purchase of selected toilet models.

DUAL FLUSH TOILET REBATES: \$50 rebate per toilet for new properties installing dual flush toilets.

SHOWERHEADS AND AERATORS: Free showerheads and aerators for properties with older fixtures.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM UPGRADE REBATES: Rebates for installation of new weather-based controllers, rain sensors, and other hardware.

Commercial Properties

CONSERVATION AUDITS: Free audits to identify opportunities to cut water waste and inefficiency.

REPLACEMENT TOILETS/REBATES: Free high-efficiency toilets to replace "tank style" toilets installed before 1994. Rebates of \$120 for waterless urinals; \$80 for old toilet replacement; \$50 for new properties installing dual flush toilets; \$20 for upgrades to flush valve toilets.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM UPGRADE REBATES: Rebates for installation of new weather-based controllers, rain sensors, and other hardware.

PRE-RINSE SPRAY HEADS: Free installation of high-efficiency pre-rinse spray heads for dishwashing stations in restaurants and cafeterias.

COMMERCIAL PROCESS UPGRADES: Financial assistance is available for water use efficiency upgrades to car washes, watercooled ice makers, HVAC systems, commercial clothes washers and other commercial water uses. Projects are considered on a case-by-case basis and are dependent on current funding.

By installing efficient water fixtures and practicing good conservation habits, residents can reduce daily household water use by up to 30%.
