HOUSEHOLD ITEMS



Appliances & Metals

- ▶ Aluminum
- ▶ Auto parts
- ▶ Barbecues
- ▶ Brass
- ▶ Copper
- ▶ Dishwashers
- ▶ Dryers
- ▶ Electric lawnmowers (remove battery first)
- ▶ Exercise equipment
- ▶ Iron
- ▶ Metal lawn chairs
- ▶ Metal push and gas lawnmowers (drain oil and gasoline first)
- ▶ Microwaves
- ▶ Steel
- ▶ Stoves
- ▶ Washers

NOT ACCEPTED

Containers that previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, or paint.



Car Seats & Boosters

- ▶ Expired child car seats and boosters.



Foam Blocks & Packing Peanuts

- ▶ White foam/expanded polystyrene blocks (look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol)
- ▶ Packing peanuts (any color; keep in a box or bag)

All items must be clean and dry.

NOT ACCEPTED

Urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, and expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.



Rigid Plastics

- ▶ Buckets
- ▶ Children's toys
- ▶ Coolers
- ▶ Laundry baskets
- ▶ Plastic lawn furniture
- ▶ PVC pipes
- ▶ Sports bottles

Confidential Document Shredding



Shredding and recycling of confidential paper documents. Shredding on site by request. Staples are okay. No binder clips.

LIMIT: Five file-size (15"L x 10"W x 12"H) boxes or equivalent. No exceptions.

ELECTRONICS



Lead Acid Batteries

- ▶ Lead acid batteries for cars, trucks, boats, and motorcycles

NOT ACCEPTED


AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries, rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.



Electronic Equipment

- ▶ Blu-ray/DVD players
- ▶ Cell phones
- ▶ Computer keyboards
- ▶ Computer mice
- ▶ Copiers
- ▶ Fax machines
- ▶ Printers
- ▶ Scanners
- ▶ Stereo equipment
- ▶ VCRs

Be sure to delete or remove personal data stored in your electronics.



BULKY ITEMS



Mattresses & Box Springs

- ▶ Mattresses and box springs only, any size

FEE: \$15 each mattress
\$15 each box spring

NOT ACCEPTED

Wet or soiled items, furniture, or frames.



Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners & Water Heaters

- ▶ Refrigerators and freezers
FEE: \$25 each
- ▶ Air conditioners
FEE: \$33 each
- ▶ Water heaters with insulation coating
FEE: \$5 each



Porcelain Toilets & Sinks

- ▶ Porcelain toilets and sinks.

Remove toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings.

FEE: \$15 each

GARAGE & YARD



Clean Scrap Wood

- ▶ Milled lumber
- ▶ Plywood
- ▶ Pallets

These wood products must be untreated and unpainted. No need to remove nails.

NOT ACCEPTED

Furniture, yard waste, stumps, branches, construction or demolition material.



Propane Tanks

- ▶ Empty residential propane tanks
FEE: \$5 each
- ▶ Small empty camping stove tanks
FEE: \$1 each

TVs, Computers & Monitors

TVs, computers, computer monitors, tablets, e-readers, and portable DVD players are **not** accepted at this event. Find locations to recycle them at no cost at ecyclewa.org.

Tires

- ▶ Bias ply, steel belted, studded tires.

LIMIT: Each car may dispose of six passenger tires (18 inches and smaller) not on rims free of charge

FEE: \$2.00 for each tire on a rim

FEE FOR TRUCK TIRES:

\$5 each large truck tire
\$15 each truck tire on rim

NOT ACCEPTED

Oversized tires.

Fluorescent, CFL & HID Lights

Fluorescent, CFL and HID light are **not** accepted at this event. Find locations to recycle them at no cost at lightrecycle.org. Fluorescents are also accepted at the Factoria Waste Drop-Off Site.
