New Bridges

Visit this table to discuss the: (1) design of the bridges – some sketches and drawings will be available to review; (2) new regulatory and safety requirements that will be incorporated into the designs; (3) City's process for acquiring additional property easements, if required; and (4) schedule and timing of construction.

New Stormwater Outfalls

Visit this table to discuss the: (1) potential locations of these proposed outfalls; (2) water quality treatment to be incorporated; (3) City's process for acquiring property easements; and (4) schedule and timing of construction.

Streamside Property Owners

Visit this table to discuss: (1) what streamside property owners need to know if they would like to do work *in* Lower Coal Creek; (2) what state, federal and City permits would likely be needed; and (3) the benefits of a Vegetation Management Plan to streamline permitting.

Other Projects

Visit this table to discuss the following infrastructure-related efforts:

Sewer System: (1) smoke and dye testing for the sewer system; and (2) the Infiltration and Inflow (I/I) program.

Traffic Safety: (1) the alternative designs for improving safety at the entrance of Newport Shores; and (2) the schedule and timing of construction.
